

Dear Parent/Guardian,

In our best effort to support Nanuet students and families with our in-school, online, and hybrid learning models, the Nanuet Union Free School District is pleased to announce that beginning with the 2020-2021 school year students K-12 will be able to use the school Chomebook computers at home.

Each student will be assigned a Chromebook to use at home and at school. The Chromebooks are the property of the Nanuet Union Free School District and we expect that students will use them in accordance with our Network and Internet Acceptable Use Policy for Students. As with textbooks and other school materials, students are expected to take good care of the Chromebook and are responsible for any damage that may occur.

Content Filtering: District issued Chromebooks include content filters that are in compliance with the Federally mandated Children's Internet Protection Act. Internet activity is protected and monitored by the District (filtering or blocking of access to certain material on the Internet) through the use of a remote monitoring tool whether the device is in school or at home.

Responsible Use: The Nanuet Union Free School District considers digital learning resources to be powerful and valuable educational tools. We encourage the use of the Chromebook, both in school and at home, as a tool to provide opportunities for students to complete school-related assignments and projects.

Expectations specific to the District's 1:1 Chromebook program include the following:

- All students are responsible at all times (both in school and at home) for abiding by the District's Network and Internet Acceptable Use Policy for Students when using their Chromebook.
- The Chromebook is assigned to a specific student and is the responsibility of that student until the device is returned.
- Students should bring their Chromebook to school each day with a fully charged battery. Only the charging equipment given to with the Chromebook should be used to charge the device.
- Students are responsible for the care and upkeep of the Chromebook and for keeping the device in good physical condition.



- Chromebooks should be stored in a safe place when not in use. When in school, the device should not be left unsecured in an unsupervised area.
- District owned Chromebooks should not be taken to an outside computer service for any type of repair or maintenance.
- Any damage to the Chromebook should immediately be reported to the Main Office of the school building.
- Any issue other than damage should be reported to tech support staff using the online form,
 Chromebook Support Request
- Chromebooks have a District label and serial number tag affixed to them. Both identifiers must remain on the device and not be removed or altered.
- Students should have no expectation of confidentiality or privacy with respect to use of the
 Chromebook. The District may without prior notice of consent supervise, log, access, view,
 monitor, and record use of the student Chromebook at any time, for any reason related to the
 operation of the District. By using a school-issued Chromebook, the student agrees to such access,
 monitoring, and recording of use.
- Students should protect their usernames and passwords used to log into the Chromebooks. This
 information should not be shared.
