## PROCESS FOR REQUESTING WHSAA SANCTIONING OF ADDITIONAL ACTIVITY

WHSAA Rule 3.9.1 "Eight member schools must be committed to participation for a new activity to be sanctioned by the WHSAA"

Request must be made by an administration of WHSAA member school.

Request must be made on the appropriate form.

Letters of commitment from schools committed to the sponsoring of the activity must accompany the request.

Request will be placed on the agenda for the next regularly scheduled meeting of the WHSAA Handbook Committee for their recommendation.

Handbook committee will review the request and forward a recommendation on to the WHSAA Board of Directors. This could involve a request for gathering additional information, which might mean that the Handbook Committee's recommendation would not go before the WHSAA Board at their accompanying meeting.

The WHSAA board will act on the Handbook Committee's recommendation at the next regularly scheduled meeting.

The request for sanctioning would have to pass two readings at the WHSAA Board Meetings.

The implementing of any new activities sanctioned by the WHSAA would have to follow the guidelines of WHSAA Rule 3.1.25
