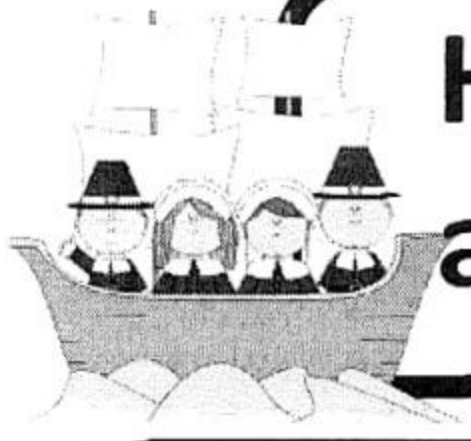
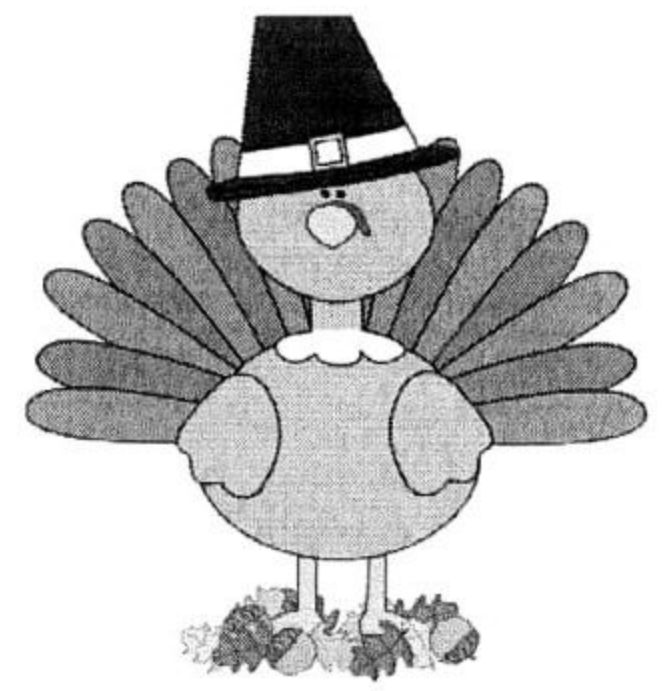

and Parents!**

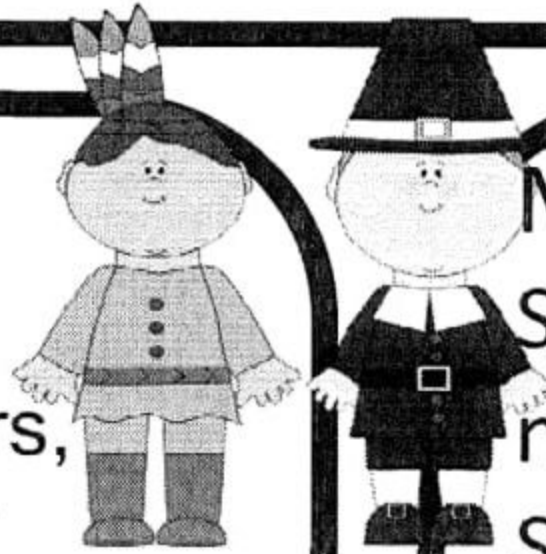


Highlights:
