

Dear Steger School District 194 students and parents,

Below you will find some learning materials that have been created to ensure students continue to receive access to instructional resources because of the school closure due to COVID-19.

Examples of learning activities that can be done at home:

- Have students write reflection essays about a movie watched or a book read
- Keep a reading log of the name of the book and the minutes read per day
- Math flashcards
- Log on to your Reading Street and Go Math sites (First Grade/SIC only)

Examples of learning activities that can be done at home with **students enrolled at SPC** (Grades Prek - First):

- Read aloud picture story books to your child and have them identify the character and setting of the story. Have them retell the story in sequence, providing details that are necessary for a listener to understand the story.
- Read non-fiction books to your child and have them recall key details about the topic (describe the animals habitat, the animals diet, etc.)
- Practice writing letters, numbers and sight/high-frequency words in salt, with finger paint, or on a white board.
- Practice putting numbers together ($4+3=7$) and taking numbers apart ($7=4+3$) using items for counters (beans, pasta, etc.). Write the equation, too!
