Pearl River High School is now using an online tracking and reporting system for service hours called x2VOL. We truly believe in the benefits of this system such as the elimination of paper forms and the centralization of students' information but understand there are concerns about transitioning during the school year. Rest assured, all the service hours students previously submitted have been imported into their x2Vol accounts and their paper files will be retained until graduation.

X2VOL allows students to enter their service hours online at any time, check and register for volunteer opportunities, monitor progress towards awards and print a service hour log that can be used as a reference for National, subject Honor Societies and college applications.


As in the past, all community service activities need to be unpaid and participation on a PRHS team is excluded from these goals.
