RETURN TO SCHOOL PROTOCOLS



- NO COVID SYMPTOMS
- NO COVID EXPOSURE


PROCEED TO SCHOOL



EXPOSURE to COVID, NO SYMPTOMS

- Students in school: masked and maintained three feet of physical distance may proceed to school
- Adults in school: masked and maintained six feet of physical distance may proceed to school
- Must provide to School Nurse:
 - Proof of full vaccination OR
 - Proof of COVID diagnosis within 3 months


PROCEED TO SCHOOL



EXPOSURE to COVID, NO SYMPTOMS

If unmasked and unvaccinated at time of exposure, must stay home for 10 days since last exposure.


CANNOT GO TO SCHOOL



COVID DIAGNOSIS, NO SYMPTOMS

Home for 10 days since first positive COVID-19 Test

CANNOT GO TO SCHOOL




COVID EXPOSURE, SYMPTOMS*

- Get COVID-19 tested (Conventional RT-PCR test or NAAT tests accepted)
- Home for 10 Days since last date of exposure
- Negative Test Result: Home for 10 days since last date of exposure and fever free for 24 hours and symptoms improving
- Positive Test Result: Home until 10 days since test results and no fever for 72 hours (without fever medication) and symptoms improving

CANNOT GO TO SCHOOL

*COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

- Fever of 100 or greater
- Chills
- Muscle pain or body aches
- Shortness of breath
- Cough, congestion or runny nose
- Sore throat
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea



AT LEAST 1 SYMPTOM* in the last 48 hours

home until:

- Provide a copy of the negative test results to the School Nurse (PCR or NAAT Test) or a note from Health Care Provider (HCP) indicating result/type of test. Must be 24 hours fever free without fever reducing medicines AND symptom(s) must be resolving
- OR
- Home for 10 days since first positive COVID-19 Test
- OR
- Your child's HCP provides a note confirming an acute illness (examples: lab confirmed influenza, strep throat). Note must include that COVID-19 is NOT suspected and the alternative, acute diagnosis must be explained
- OR
- A note from the HCP documenting an unconfirmed acute illness/diagnosis, such as upper respiratory illness or viral gastroenteritis, will not suffice.
- If POSITIVE COVID-19 test Home until:
 - 10 days since date of test,
 - No fever for 72 hours (without fever medication),
 - Symptoms improving
