



Rockland Business Women's Network Scholarship Application

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the RBWN scholarship is to provide tuition assistance to a female candidate graduating from high school, subject to eligibility requirements below, and enrolling in an undergraduate program in the fall.

AWARD BENEFITS:

Recipient(s) will be awarded an amount, up to \$1,000 per recipient, to be determined after a review of applications by the RBWN Scholarship Committee.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT:

Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. A completed application must be **received** by close of business (5 PM) Friday, March 22, 2019. Late applications will not be considered. There are no exceptions to this policy.
2. Applicant must be scholastically responsible with a grade point average of "B" (3.0) or better at the time of the application and provide a copy of report card or official transcript for the 2018-19 academic year to date.
3. Applicant must be accepted to at least one certified undergraduate program for the fall semester immediately following the submission of the application and plan to attend such program.
4. Applicant must be graduating from high school in the spring of 2019 from:
 - a. A high school located in Rockland County, NY

OR

- b. A high school outside of Rockland County, but applicant must live in Rockland County.
5. Applicant must submit **one (1)*** recommendation letter from a **non-family member** and submit a list of extracurricular and community service activities *(additional recommendation letters will not be reviewed).
 6. Applicant must submit an essay of **500 words or less describing *how a positive female role model has influenced the applicant's life and/or her community*** (longer essays will not be considered).
 7. Once selected, candidate must submit proof of acceptance for the upcoming academic year by April 26, 2019.
 8. Scholarship recipients **must** attend the RBWN Women in Business Awards Breakfast on **Tuesday, June 11, 2019** in Rockland County to receive their award. The scholarship recipient and one guest will be complimentary guests of RBWN for this event.

4. A list of extracurricular activities and community service performed during high school.
