In addition to the conduction of the Asbestos Hazards Emergency Response Act (AHERA) triennial inspection and modification of the district's management plan reflecting the results of the inspection.

INSURANCE AGREEMENT:

- I. Notwithstanding any terms, conditions or provisions, in any other writing between the parties, the consultant hereby agrees to effectuate the naming of the district as an unrestricted additional insured on the consultant's insurance policies, with the exception of workers' compensation and professional liability. If the policy is written on a claims-made basis, the retroactive date must precede the date of the contract.
- II. The policy naming the district as an additional insured shall:
 - Purchase an insurance policy from an A.M. Best rated "secured" insurer, authorized to conduct business in New York State.
 - Contain a 30-day notice of cancellation.
 - State that the organization's coverage shall be primary coverage for the District, its Board, employees and volunteers.
 - The district shall be listed as an additional insured by using endorsement CG 2026 or broader. The certificate must state that this endorsement is being used. If another endorsement is used, a copy shall be included with the certificate of insurance.
- III. The consultant agrees to indemnify the district for any applicable deductibles.
- IV. Required Insurance:
 - Commercial General Liability Insurance

\$1,000,000 per occurrence/ \$2,000,000 aggregate.

Automobile Liability

\$1,000,000 combined single limit for owned, hired and borrowed and non-owned motor vehicles.

- Workers' Compensation and N.Y.S. Disability
 - Statutory Workers' Compensation, Employers' Liability and N.Y.S. Disability Benefits Insurance for all employees.
- Auditor's Professional Errors and Omissions Insurance
 - \$1,000,000 per occurrence/\$2,000,000 aggregate for the professional acts of the auditor performed under the contract for the district. If written on a "claims-made" basis, the retroactive date must pre-date the inception of the contract or agreement. Coverage shall remain in effect for two years following the completion of work.
- Fidelity Bond

For dishonest acts of the auditor's employees, with client coverage.

- Excess Insurance
 - On a "Follow-Form" basis, with limits of \$3,000,000 each occurrence and aggregate.
- VI. Consultant acknowledges that failure to obtain such insurance on behalf of the district constitutes a material breach of contract. The consultant is to provide the districts with a certificate of insurance, evidencing the above requirements have been met, prior to the commencement of work or use of facilities. The failure of the district to object to the contents of the certificate or the absence of same shall not be deemed a waiver of any and all rights held by the district.
- VI. The district is a member/owner of the NY Schools Insurance Reciprocal (NYSIR). The consultant further acknowledges that the procurement of such insurance as required herein is intended to benefit not only the district but also the NYSIR, as the district's insurer.

NON-COLLUSIVE BIDDING CERTIFICATION

I. General Bid Certification

The proposer certifies that he will furnish the prices hereby quoted for the services as proposed in this RFP.

II. Non-Collusive Bidding Certification

By submission of this proposal, the proposer certifies that he is complying with Section 103-d of the General Municipal law of the State of New York as follows: "Statement of non-collusion in bids and proposals to political subdivision of the state. Every bid or proposal hereafter made to a political subdivision of the state or any public department, agency or official thereof where competitive bidding is required by statute, rule, regulation, or local law, for work or services performed or to the performed or goods sold or to be sold, shall contain the following statement subscribed by the Bidder and affirmed by such Bidder as true under the penalties of perjury: Non-collusion bidding certification".

- (a) By submission of this proposal, each proposer and each person signing on behalf of any proposer certifies, under penalty of perjury, that to the best of knowledge and belief:
- (1) The prices in this proposal have been arrived at independently without collusion, consultation, communication or agreement for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices with any other proposer or with any competitor;
- (2) Unless otherwise required by law, the prices which have been quoted in this proposal have not been knowingly disclosed by the proposer and will not knowingly be disclosed by the proposer prior to opening, directly or indirectly, to any other proposer or to any competitor;
- (3) No attempts have been made or will be made by the proposer to induce any other person, partnership or corporation to submit or not to submit a proposal for the purpose of restricting competition.
- (b) A proposal shall not be considered for award nor shall any award be made where (a) (1) (2) and (3) above have not been complied with; provided, however, that if in any case the proposer cannot make the foregoing certification, the proposer shall so state and shall furnish with the bid a signed statement which sets forth in details the reason therefore. Where (a) (1) (2) and (3) above have not been complied with, the proposal shall not be considered for award nor shall any award be made unless the head of purchasing department, agency or official thereof to which the proposal is made, or his designee, determines that such disclosure was not made for the purpose of restricting competition.

The fact that a proposer (a) has published price lists, rates, or tariffs covering items being procured, (b) has informed prospective customers of proposed or pending publication of new or revised price lists for such items, or (c) has sold the same items to other customers at the same prices being bid, does not constitute, without more, a disclosure within the meaning of subparagraph one (a).

Any proposal hereafter made to any political subdivision of the state or any public department, agency or official thereof by a corporate proposer for work or services performed or to be performed or goods sold or to be sold, where competitive bidding is required by statute rule, regulation or local law, and where such proposal contains the certification referred to in subdivision one of the section, shall be deemed to have been authorized by the board of directors of the proposer, and such authorization shall be deemed to include the signing and submission of the proposal and the inclusion therein of the certificate as to non-collusion as the act and deed of the firm.
