Lesson Title	Objectives Students will be able to:
Recognizing Feelings	Students learn to identify and demonstrate the physical signs of different emotions. Students discuss how various emotions look, sound, and feel, and then practice demonstrating and identifying different emotions
Predicting Feelings	Students discuss how to think ahead and predict emotions that might result from a given situation, and then practice predicting how a peer might feel in different situations.
Explaining Feelings	Students discuss how to think back to what happened first or look for situational cues in order to understand reasons for someone's feelings. Students brainstorm reasons that people can have different feelings.
Having Empathy	Students discuss what it means to have empathy for someone, and brainstorm ways to show empathy and caring to someone in different situations.
Understanding Stereotypes	Students discuss how not everyone in a group is just the same, and practice a way to respond to differences.
Understanding Stereotypes	Students discuss how everyone can make choices and discover that toys, activities, and roles can be for everyone.
Understanding That People Can Change	Students discuss the potential for growth, learning, and change in themselves and others and identify how they have changed.
