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## NAACP YOUTH & COLLEGE DIVISION STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Members shall be prompt and prepared for all scheduled activities
2. Proper conduct of the members is a personal responsibility as well as the responsibility of the chaperones to ensure.
3. Members shall not deface public property nor remove hotel property such as keys or towels from the premises. The individual will pay for any property damages or losses incurred.
4. Keep chaperones advised at all times of activities and whereabouts.
5. No UNDER-AGE members is to leave the premises without a chaperone. Do not take a taxi or other public transportation to restaurants or areas of sightseeing without chaperone approval.
6. After curfew, members of the opposite sex are not allowed in each other's rooms for any reason. (Curfew is 12:00 a.m. unless a scheduled activity goes beyond the time limit that has been set. Contestants are expected to be in their own room at curfew.)

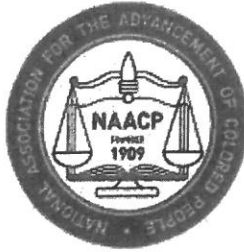

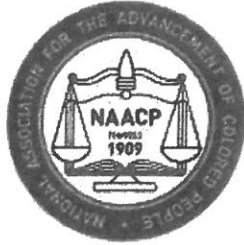
