Rules of the Race

Night at the Races is a fundraiser to benefit St. Francis Xavier Catholic School. The event is open to all. Adults only please; no one under 21 will be allowed. Only 300 tickets will be sold to this event.

What is Night at the Races?

Night at the Races is an event where the fun and excitement of thoroughbred horse racing is delivered to you in the form of high quality, professional video and emceed live at the event. Join the excitement of cheering your favorites on to the finish line! Attendees bet on their favorites of each race to win with payoffs. Bets are in \$2 increments.

The racing line up includes 10 races with 10 horses each, followed by an 11th auction race. For the first 10 races, horses may be owned if purchased before the event date. Horses are \$10 each, and the owners are recognized in the program. Each horse is randomly assigned to one of the 10 races and to a post position. The owners of the winning horses are then entered into the Winner's Circle for a chance to win a cash prize which is drawn at the end of the night. You can purchase horses without attending the event.

The 11th auction race is an opportunity to buy and name a horse, and each horse is sold to the highest bidder. The owner of the winning horse for this race receives half the proceeds from the auction!

What does Night at the Races cost?

This is a fundraiser for St. Francis Xavier School and each ticket is only \$20. The ticket includes admission to the event, dinner and drinks. The ticket price does not include the purchase of horses. Throughout the night, there will be small games of chance and a 50/50 raffle. Refreshments will be provided.
