Please have all items on the first day of school.

EVERY DAY STUDENTS MUST have these materials throughout the ENTIRE school year:

• 2 blue ball point pens, erasable

• 2 black ball point pens, erasable

• 2 sharpened pencils with an eraser

• soft zippered pencil case

• 5 book sox or brown paper – ALL hard back textbooks MUST be covered

• small assortment of colored pencils, crayons OR markers

<u>SUPPLIES to turn into the homeroom teacher</u> on the first day of school:

• 2 boxes of tissues

• 1 container of Clorox wipes

6th, 7th, and 8th grade Science and Religion supplies:

• 3 ring binder – 1 inch size

• 2 - pocket folders

6th, 7th, and 8th grade English and Reading supplies:

• 2 – pocket folders

• 12 inch ruler (customary & metric)

glue stick

2 red pens

scissors

2 highlighters

6th, 7th, and 8th grade Math and Social Studies supplies:

- 3 ring binder (1 inch no larger, please)
- 4 extra red pens
- earbuds (stored in backpack)

- 2 binder dividers
- reinforced edge lined paper, wide rule for 6th, 7th; college rule for 8th

It is STRONGLY RECOMMENDED that ALL students have at home:

- a New American Bible, Catholic Edition for religion homework
- an extra supply of blue and black erasable pens, pencils and paper kept at home
- contact paper all consumable soft books MUST be covered
- a working computer
- internet access to complete online work
- the ability to print assignments homework may not be printed at school
