



COVID Frequently Asked Questions From The Community

Q: How did information go out to parents to let them know about a regular day of school?

A: Via robo call, website, canvas emails to parents and students

Q: What will a day look like?

A: Student Check in day

Q: Am I riding bus with 2 people?

A: Initially there will be one student to a seat. If for some reason the bus fills up, we will not turn students away. We ask that students keep masks on and stay in their seats.

Q: How often will buses be sanitized?

A: After each drop off

Q: Will students be required to wear Uniforms?

A: Uniforms are Not required

Q: Will students use lockers and bring book bags?

A: Lockers will be provided for MS & HS students only. We will socially distance lockers as well.

Q: Will students use lockers and bring book bags?

A: Book bags will be permitted for MS & HS students only

Q: Will Walkers temperatures be taken?

A: Students who walk to school, will have temps taken at the door.

Q: Why wasn't the green plan implemented?

A: The school board and superintendent looked at the data and the increase in cases; therefore the decision was made to go red

Q: Was the survey for parents to decide whether or not their students were going to come back to school?

A: Yes, parents were asked before the start of school which format they preferred. They were also asked to complete the survey recently again with the deadline of September 30th in order for staff to adjust accordingly.



Q: Parent concern - If a parent has one kid at the HS who tests positive and another student at elementary school (who does not test positive) are both students required to quarantine?

A: Yes, both students will quarantine. Contact tracing will be done for both students and notification will be sent out.

Q: What Safety precautions will be put in place for teachers, community, students?

A: Teachers and students are required to wear masks, use sanitizer and wash hands frequently. Students and teachers are to social distance in and outside of classrooms. Sanitizer has been and will continue to be provided. There will be a COVID room in each building. Students and/or teachers who feel ill should be sent to the COVID room for further investigation.

Q: What's the responsibility of the teacher?

A: To provide a quality instruction and work to ensure a safe and healthy environment for all students.

Q: Will the school hours will be same as regular school day?

A: Yes (both virtual and traditional hours will be the same)

Q: Has technology been ordered?

A: Yes - the order is expected at the end of October/beginning of November

Q: Since students are eating in the classrooms at the elementary level, where will the teachers be eating when students are in the classrooms?

A: Student cafeteria (and other areas)

Q: Who's covering classes when teachers are having lunch?

A: Building principals are designing schedules for coverage

Q: What are we doing to try to reach the parents and caregivers of students who have not logged on?

A: Deans and admin are reaching out to parents and students. We also have truancy officers visiting homes.

Q: Several issues of cases of COVID - what is the protocol?

A: When a teacher or student tests positive for COVID, they are required to quarantine for 10 - 14 days.

Q: Are the masks different sizes? KGN need small masks.

A: Yes , masks for students with smaller faces were sent to each building (they are housed in the Nurse's office)
