## Two Things You Need to Know

#### **#1. PROPOSITION 1:**

Vote on the Proposed 2019-20 School Budget of \$69,240,850

Estimated Tax Rate Increase for Homeowners: approximately 0.6%

Estimated Tax Rate Increase for Non-Homestead: approximately 3.4%

Important Note: Tax rates are estimates only and may change due to adjustments in total assessments and base proportion allocations between homestead and non-homestead properties which are not finalized until August.

- Implementation of Next Generation Math Standards
- New Science 21 in Grades K-3
- Pilot of Science 21 curriculum in Grade 4
- Adds 1 HS Special Education/Literacy teacher
- New HS electives in Art and Science
- New K-7 Computer Science curriculum
- Adds 1 District School Psychologist
- Implementation of BOCES Managed IT platform
- Expansion of 1:1 Chromebook Initiative
- Addition of Music First software for grades K-12
- Maintains continuum of special education services;
- Maintains 72 athletic teams (varsity, JV, modified, and intramurals);
- Maintains extra-curricular clubs at all schools;
- Maintains adult enrichment program for community and senior citizens.
