## Alternate Electives

An "alternate" is a "just in case" class.

- The semester classes that students do not choose automatically become the alternate electives.

For example, if I choose Band, Art, and World Language as my top choices then Music Technology/Piano Lab and Computer Technology become my alternate electives.

## Registering for Courses

- Fifth grade teachers will show students a video that goes over the classes and course registration form
- Fifth grade teachers will make recommendations on the form for math and history
- Students should bring the form home to choose electives and review with parent for signature
- Form should be returned to fifth grade teacher

4. Code RVA (Computer Science, Associate's Degree from J. Sargeant Reynolds Community College)

Students can apply to these programs during Fall of 8th grade year. There are Fall information sessions. Must be in Algebra 1 in 8th grade for all but CodeRVA.
