The adult basic education program provides instruction in reading, writing, and mathematics that will assist in preparation for achieving a passing score on the High School Equivalency Assessment (HSEA). You will be given an individual assessment to determine exactly what you need to study to pass the assessment. Based upon the results, your instructor will prepare a specific learning plan designed to help you achieve your goals. You will be able to study at your own pace with the help of an instructor...all in a supporting and friendly environment for adult learners.

HSEA preparation classes focus on the basic academic skills of reading, writing, critical thinking, and problem solving and offer small-group, whole-group, and individual instruction. A multisensory approach incorporates different learning styles. Classes are offered at no cost. You must be an Indiana resident to receive services.
