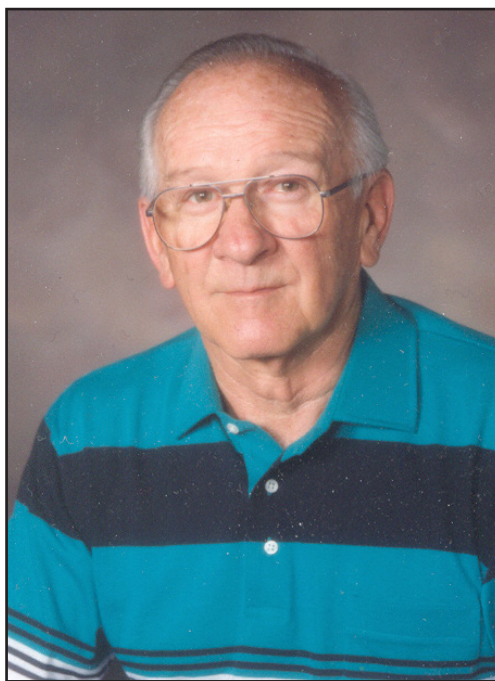

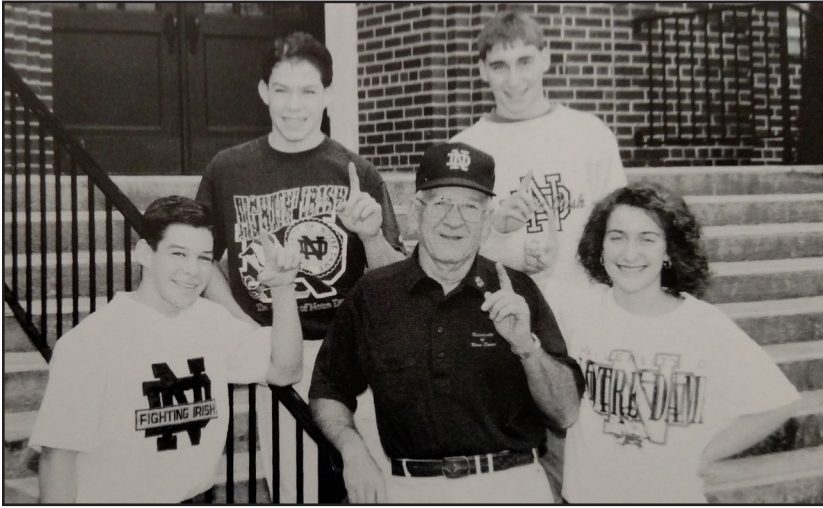

Welcome to the 25th-Annual Henny Noel Memorial Golf Tournament! Many thanks for spending your day with us and for helping us to reach a significant milestone in this event's history. Many events get started, but not a lot of them reach their silver anniversary!

This tournament started in the summer of 1994 when emotions were still very raw following Henny's sudden passing on Dec. 29, 1993. He is still missed tremendously by not only his wife, children and grandchildren, but also by his extended Delone Catholic family. He was a fixture in the school's maintenance department from 1958 until his retirement just days before his passing.

As someone who cared deeply about the students at Delone Catholic, I think Henny would be humbled to know that so much good has come about because his family and friends wanted to honor his memory. Over the past 24 years, this tournament has raised more than \$181,000 (see next page for full details) to provide tuition assistance to students attending Delone Catholic as part of an overall tuition assistance program that helps around 25 percent of our families each year. These funds have always been important, but even more so during this past decade that has seen such economic turmoil in our nation. We have been able to educate young people who may not have otherwise been able to consider Delone Catholic without this help.

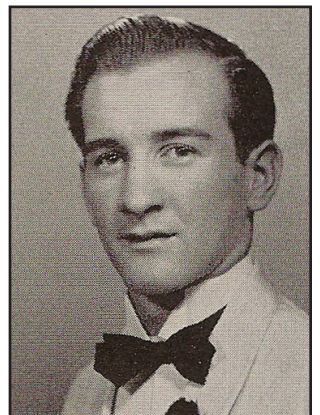

## HOW DO THESE FUNDS HELP DELONE CATHOLIC STUDENTS?

### Looking Back/Looking Ahead

Throughout the history of the Henny Noel Memorial Golf Tournament, all funds raised were awarded as Tuition Assistance in the summer following that year's tournament. For example, the funds from the first tournament in 1994 were awarded in the summer of 1995 for use in the 1995-96 school year. That practice continued through the 2014 tournament.

In recent years, more sponsors have come on board, and existing and new sponsors have generously reached new levels of support. Because of this success, and with the blessing of the Noel Family, a change has been made with an eye to helping even more students now and in the future. Of the \$16,998.37 raised in 2017, 75 percent (\$12,748.78) will be awarded in the coming weeks for the 2018-19 school year. The remaining 25 percent (\$4,249.59) will be placed into a separate, permanent account where it will always be earning a return. That return will be used to supplement the income from future golf tournaments and ensure that the Henny Noel Scholarship will always exist for students at Delone Catholic.

## DELONE CATHOLIC TUITION AND ASSISTANCE FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **How much is the current tuition at Delone Catholic High School?**

The Board of Directors strives to make a Catholic education affordable for all. The full cost to educate one student at Delone Catholic is \$7,790 for the 2018-19 school year. With base tuition for 2018-19 set at \$5,950 (for students in supporting parishes), every family actually receives some scholarship support even before applying for additional support.

Supporting Catholic deanery parishes contribute more than \$600,000 annually thus providing scholarships for every student and family. The amount of this support is more for parishioners of these parishes. We encourage Maryland families to seek assistance from their own parish.

### **How do I know if I am eligible for tuition assistance?**

Tuition assistance can only be determined by applying to the FACTS service. FACTS is an objective and professional organization that specializes in student aid analysis using federal methodology. Delone Catholic uses the services of FACTS to assist us in determining the assistance amount for each family. After examining each family situation, a decision is made on eligibility for tuition assistance. Priority will be given to Catholic families who are registered in their parish and actively participate in parish life.

### **How can I apply for tuition assistance?**

Tuition assistance applications are available in the Business Office and will be posted on [www.DeloneCatholic.org](http://www.DeloneCatholic.org) by Jan. 31. Both Pennsylvania and Maryland residents should complete the FACTS online application. In order to fill out the application, you will need a complete copy of this year's or last year's IRS Form 1040, your current W-2's and your current PA-40 or utility bill. There is a processing fee of approximately \$30 for this application.

### **Where does tuition assistance come from and how much is available?**

Tuition assistance provided by Delone Catholic High School comes from a variety of generous supporters, including local parishes, generous benefactors and the Neumann Scholarship Program. The Neumann Scholarship, administered by the Diocese of Harrisburg, uses Pennsylvania's Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) funds; these funds in turn come from generous businesses who direct their tax dollars to provide tuition subsidies for our students. Only Pennsylvania residents are eligible for Neumann Scholarships. In addition to the Neumann Scholarships, Delone Catholic has 16 additional tuition assistance funds established by a variety of benefactors. Interest earned each year is given out in tuition assistance to both Pennsylvania and Maryland residents. In the 2015-16 school year, we awarded more than \$198,000 in tuition assistance.

Note: When you submit your FACTS application, you are automatically considered for these tuition assistance funds. If you receive any of these funds, you will be notified by July 31. If you receive Neumann Scholarship funds, the Diocese will send a letter informing you of the Neumann Scholarship amount in mid-July.

### **When is the deadline to apply for tuition assistance?**

The deadline to submit your FACTS application is April 15. In order to make sure that you are eligible for tuition assistance, you must meet all deadlines. After the deadline, we cannot guarantee tuition assistance since funds will diminish and may not be available at a later date.

### **When will I know if I receive tuition assistance?**

The Diocese will inform you of Neumann Scholarship amounts in mid-July. Delone Catholic will contact you by letter by July 31.

### **What if our financial situation changes after I apply for tuition assistance?**

We understand that hardships can occur. A parent can be laid off, lose a job or encounter medical problems. If your family experiences at least a 10 percent decrease in income, write to the Finance Committee explaining the change in situation. The committee will review your eligibility for additional assistance.

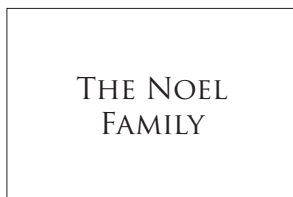

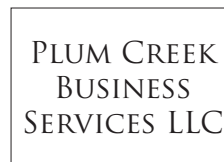
