

## SENIOR INCENTIVE ACTIVITIES NEWSLETTER

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We would like to take this opportunity to remind families of important senior incentive activities and dates. Please keep in mind that all participation in incentive activities is contingent upon academic performance, behavior, and attendance.

#### ELIGIBLE STUDENTS

In order to be eligible to attend incentive activities, students *must meet all four requirements*:

- Passing grades in all MAJOR classes (ELA, Math, Science, Spanish) with a minimum average of 65%
- Maintaining 80% attendance including lateness
- Demonstrating good judgment in behavior as evidenced by maintaining a minimum of 108 weekly points on the behavior tracker

#### **INELIGIBLE STUDENTS**

Students who meet any one of the following will automatically be *ineligible to attend at least one incentive activity.* Students who meet multiple criteria are at risk from being banned from all incentive activities:

- 1 or more suspensions
  Please note: Any student who receives a Superintendent's Suspension will automatically be ineligible to attend all incentive activities.
- Pattern of persistent detentions
- Pattern of persistent phone calls home regarding poor behavior
- Pattern of non-compliance with school cell phone policy

Students who meet and/or exceed requirements will be invited to attend incentive activities, which include incentive field trips, stepping up ceremony, and the senior dance. Please refer to the table on the back of this letter for payment due dates as well as the scheduled events. Please remember that these payments are an **estimate** and are subject to change.

\*\* Students will not be permitted to pay for senior trip or senior dance in advance – they must first receive an invitation before payment.\*\*

# Students who are ineligible for incentive activities may still be permitted to attend the stepping up ceremony, which is contingent upon promotion status.
