Daily Temperature Screening Protocols (rev. 9/25/20)

NYS Department of Health and NYS Education Department require that daily temperature screenings take place for staff and students. It is recommended that this takes place at home before reporting to school.

- Parents are to ensure that they take their child's temperature each morning and complete an electronic temperature screening and questionnaire form attesting that their child's temperature is BELOW 100.0 degrees and your child is not exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Forms must be filled out by 7 AM for HS/MS students, and by 8 AM for elementary students.
- Students who have not submitted a daily temperature screening and questionnaire form electronically, will be denied entry to class until the student is screened at school.
- Any student who has a temperature of 100 degrees or more, or <u>any symptom of</u> <u>COVID-19</u> will be isolated and a parent/guardian or emergency contact must come pick up the child.
- The district is currently using a Google form for parents to fill out for the daily screening. An automated email has been set up for all parents to receive a reminder and link to the form at 6 AM each morning.

Tips for Parents:

- \Rightarrow Leave a thermometer in a common location every night as a morning reminder.
- ⇒ Be familiar with the <u>list of symptoms</u> to look out for on a daily basis and ask your child how they are feeling each morning.
- ⇒ Please be sure that your emergency contacts are up to date in eSchoolData (Parent Portal)
- ⇒ Complete the screening by 7 AM for HS/MS students and 8 AM for elementary students.
