Who is eligible?

- Videos may feature students, their parents and/or other family members
- Students, guardians or alumni of existing choice programs (public school choice, charter, magnet, private school, virtual learning, or homeschool)
- Students and families who want choice in their state
- At least 18 years of age or older. Guardians can submit videos on behalf of minor students.

Judging and Prizes

Two People's Choice winners will be chosen through public voting. A panel of judges that includes representatives from national organizations representing the full spectrum of educational choice will select the grand prize winners and runners-up.

3 Grand Prize Winners - \$15,000 cash prize

3 Runners-up - \$5,000 cash prize

2 People's Choice Winners - \$5,000 cash prize
