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

COMMUNICATION WITH FAMILIES

- **Tier I:** Families are notified by classroom teacher, including an explanation of the skill(s) being targeted and the intervention
- Six Weeks Later: Teacher provides an update on progress and next steps
 - Continue? A new intervention is implemented, and communication cycle begins again
 - **Cease?** Student receives support to remain in LRE
 - Advance? Family is informed the child's case will be reviewed by the IST
- Once IST Meets, communication about follow-up is provided to families by the interventionist assigned to the student
- Tier II or Tier III
 - Progress reports are sent home
 - o IST may review after a minimum of ten weeks
- If interventions are not successful, families informed case to be referred to **CSE**
