The Testing Season is upon us

Good afternoon, we have just started the busiest testing time of the school year and we want to thank you all for your hard work. ACCESS testing has started relatively smooth but as always there are a few challenges. Please ensure the following tasks are complete .

- Send in your Spring training documentation ASAP
- Send in **ALL** of your testing schedules (ISTATION, Transitional NMSBA, Science SBA, ACCESS, EOC, NMAPA)
- Remove any students who are not at your campus from Access testing sessions and ensure all students are complete. This is important so they can be moved to other locations if needed.
- Enter the Accommodation Codes for students in Access including those who can't be accommodated in certain sections (see last page)
- The SBA portal will be open soon (2/19/19) to validate students and to enter accommodations. Tests and sessions can be added beginning on the 25th Please remember that Spanish is chosen as a separate test in this system.
- Unassign student tests in Pearson if they are for some reason students are not testing (ie. Medically exempt, NMAPA, Spanish SBA, etc.)
- Please verify that the students in the TIDE portal are correct. If they were added from this office the specific coding for disabilities were not added!.

Infrastructure Trials

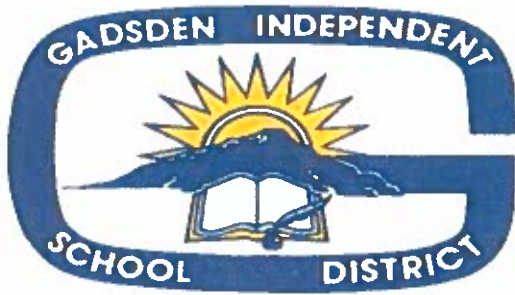
Please see the **important** notice at right regarding infrastructure trials for the transition math/ELA assessment.

Math/ELA Transition Assessment Infrastructure Trials

Because identifying potential problems before the testing window can prevent testing irregularities and student retakes, the PED and Pearson **strongly** recommend that an infrastructure trial be conducted for any school that has:

- ☐ had issues or challenges with online testing in the past
- ☐ purchased new testing devices in the past year
- ☐ changed internet service providers
- ☐ moved to a new location or opened new computer lab(s)
- ☐ hired a new STC, Tech Coordinator, or other staff not experienced with testing procedures

Please notify Tori Gilpin with the date of your infrastructure trial, and any problems that arise during the trial. Trials will be conducted at the Pearson training site: <http://trng-nm.pearsonaccessnext.com> . As in the past schools with **new STC's must run** an infrastructure trial.

NMAPA PORTAL

In the Rosters task you can create rosters of students and assign them to Test Administrators in your school. In the Online Reporting System (ORS), DTCs, STCs, and TAs can then view score reports and test data specifically for one Test Administrator and their students. For example, you can Add Rosters for 'Ms. Smith's 3rd Grade Class', and add all Grade 3 students to whom Ms. Smith is administering the NMAPA.

•The ESEA requires that a State provide appropriate accommodations for ELs with disabilities and, if an EL has a disability that precludes assessment in one or more domains of the ELP assessment such that there are **no appropriate accommodations** for the affected domain, assess the student's ELP based on the remaining domains in which it is possible to assess the student.

Students with impairments that *cannot be accommodated*:

•Indicate in the State Defined Optional Data field under Demographics in DRC

- 1 = hearing impairment (HI)
- 2 = visual impairment (VI)
- 3 = speaking domain for students taking the braille version (VIBR)
- 4 = non-verbal (NV)
