  - The proposed plans are for Football, Girls Swim, Cheer, Boys & Girls Volleyball.
  - The intent is to continue with the regional culminating event philosophy.

# Discussion:

- Cheerleading is a recognized sport by NYSPHSAA and athletes should be permitted to attend games. Cheerleaders are subject to the two spectators per player guidance.
- The inclusion of marching bands is a local district decision based upon their facility size and ability to socially distance. This is not a recognized sport and therefore, the Sport & Recreation spectator guidance is not applicable.
- Districts and non-school based venues can be more restrictive.
- (A) Consider permitting two spectators per home athlete for **indoor** Fall II sports

#### OR

(A) Consider adopting the NYSDOH spectator guidance for **indoor** Fall II sports

#### Discussion:

- Conference I voted in favor of 2 spectators per home athlete, although some were not in favor of fans at all.
- Conference II was in favor of 2 spectators per home athlete.
- Conference III is in favor of 2 spectators per home athlete due to the smaller size of the gyms.
- The Superintendents were surveyed and 91% were in favor of bringing spectators back. There are concerns around bringing back indoor spectators and how to manage it.

Motion to permit 2 spectators per home athlete for indoor fall season II sports, with the addition of 2 visiting spectators per senior athlete for the post season: Lyons / Cring Approved: Unanimous
