SCHOOL COPY RCC EARLY ADMISSION AGREEMENT

The following includes some important notes as well as a list of specific criteria, which must be met in order to qualify for graduation from Pearl River High School.

Students <u>must</u> meet with their school counselors in the Spring of their junior year to confirm all course requirements through grade 11 prior to attending RCC.

All students are expected to be enrolled as <u>full time</u> students at RCC taking 4 courses <u>plus</u> P.E. totaling a minimum of 13 credits per semester. Courses <u>must</u> include: English Composition I & II (ENG 101 & 102), Microeconomics (ECO 201), and Principles of American Government (POL 101). If for any reason a student cannot meet this requirement, he/she must see his/her Pearl River High School counselor immediately.

Students <u>must</u> return a copy of their RCC course schedule to their school counselor within two days of registering. (This procedure <u>must</u> be followed again after the Spring registration).

At the end of each semester, students must confirm that an official transcript has been received by the high school in order for counselors to certify that graduation requirements have been met.

It is the student's responsibility to request that RCC send their official transcript to the college that they will be attending after RCC.

All students enrolled in RCC are entitled to participate in all high school activities as they are still considered to be students in Pearl River.

Please be aware that courses taken at RCC do not satisfy the core course requirement for the NCAA Division 1 and 2 eligibility.

It is the sole responsibility of the student attending RCC to contact the appropriate person with any questions regarding graduation, pictures, caps and gowns, and other senior related activities and events.

Since RCC is an institution separate from PRHS, we do not include courses taken at the RCC campus in senior awards consideration or in our 7th semester GPA calculation. The student's 6th semester GPA and rank will therefore remain the same for the 7th semester. Colleges often require that we send a midyear grade report to them, so a copy of the student's fall semester transcript from RCC will be sent to all colleges that the student has applied to.

Please note that there is no guarantee that credits attained from RCC will be accepted by the future college that the student ultimately chooses to attend. If students have questions about whether credits from RCC will transfer to particular colleges, it is the students' responsibility to contact the admissions offices at their colleges of interest.

Please feel free to contact the Guidance Office with any questions and/or regarding post high school planning. Information regarding scholarships is available in the Guidance Office and on the Guidance website.
