CASUAL DRESS CODE

On certain occasions throughout the year, students may be granted permission to wear casual apparel to school or school dances. On such occasions, the following guidelines will be enforced:

- 1. No patched or torn jeans or jeans with holes in them (this includes factory made jeans with holes). No short or cutoff jeans. No hip huggers, low risers, yoga pants and no spandex pants.
- 2. No midriffs, muscle shirts or tank tops. Shirt's neckline may NOT extend below the collarbone. Shirts must extend over the jeans or slacks even when arms are raised.
- 3. No hats.
- 4. No sandals, boots or flip-flops. Shoes must have completely closed heels and closed toes. Socks must be worn. Shoelaces must be tied.
- 5. Proper undergarments must be worn.
- 6. No inappropriate/offensive slogan apparel or accessories.
- 7. All clothing must be neat and clean.
- 8. Shorts are permitted only during the time of summer uniform and must be no shorter than 2 inches above the top of the knee when standing.
- 9. Girls' skirts may be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee when standing.

Any student who is dressed in an unfit manner will be:

- 1. Issued alternate attire.
- 2. Asked to call parents to either pick them up from the dance OR bring alternate attire.
- 3. Asked to leave the dance.
