What We're Learning

Reading/Writing: Our students have been introduced to the letters N, W, P, H, M ,A, B, K, D, F, O, C, E, Y, G, T, S. We have learned about the sounds each of these letters make and things that begin with these letters. This month we will learn about the letters R, Z and I. We continue to work on writing letters and working on writing our names.

Math: We have learned about adding and the addition sign (+), the equals sign (=) and counting "How many all together". We will continue practicing adding using different manipulatives. We will learn about graphs and how graphs show us information.

Science: We will begin our Interdisciplinary Unit on Water. During this unit we will explore where we find water and the changes in water like ice and snow. We will experiment with objects to find out how they are affected by water and why some items sink or float. We will end our unit with learning how water helps living things.

Social Studies: We are learning about solutions for the social challenges we sometimes have in school like sharing, taking turns, keeping our hands to ourselves. We are learning to use solutions
