Background:

Hank Jaxel was a longtime volunteer and organizer of youth sports. He was an active volunteer in Nanuet Little League, St. Anthony's CYO basketball and the Special Olympics for decades. Hank was a leading advocate of providing more opportunities for girls in Rockland County, New York to play organized softball. As President of the Rockland County Amateur Softball Association (ASA) Umpires, he oversaw the assignment of umpires for girls recreational level softball throughout the county.

As a tribute to Hank, **ONE (1) ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000.00) DOLLAR** scholarships will be awarded to **ONE (1)** female High School graduate who participated in youth softball in Rockland County and played any sport at the High School level. The recipient will embrace the spirit and sportsmanship of the game both on and off the field. She will be entering a two or four year accredited education institution; and she will have actively participated in community service activities.

Eligibility:

**** AWARDS ARE ONE (1) TIME ONLY ****

1. The student is a college bound high school senior at the time of application;
2. The student is attending college for the first time in the Fall of 2019.
3. The student will be enrolled in either a two- or four-year accredited education institution.
4. Participated in organized youth softball in Rockland County.
5. Played any sport at the high school level in Rockland County.
6. Actively participated in community service events.
7. Have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

Application Process:

To apply, eligible applicant must complete the attached scholarship application form. Applicant should type or print clearly, and use only the space provided on the form to provide the information. Other than specified below, no attachments, resumes, pictures or other material of any kind should be submitted or used to answer the questions. The signed application must be submitted with an official high school transcript documenting the student's GPA for grades 9 through 11; and with two (2) letters of recommendation (i.e. from a teacher, athletic coach, organization where you volunteered).
