At SGL students have been working with Lincoln Center teaching artists on this play and they will continue to do work around the performance, Art, and Literacy concepts through December. Therefore, participation will count towards students' first period ELA or SS grades.

Students and teachers will take public transportation or yellow busses to and from Gerald lynch Theatre located at Hunter College. All students will be back in the building by 2:00pm and will be dismissed as usual.
