## VII. Section One Update

(I) Year in Review – Organizational Growth: Vision for the Future

# Discussion:

Todd Santabarbara spoke to three topics regarding the CIA/Section One organizational growth plan:

"Who we gree" Todd Santabarbara provided a brief review of the current staff made up of Sports I

- **"Who we are"** Todd Santabarbara provided a brief review of the current staff made up of Sports Desk Assistants(assignors), a Scheduling/Assigning Coordinator and two support staff members. This model which has not changed in a few decades, serves 77 high schools and 65 middle schools including servicing the programs of over 65,000 athletes.
- "How far we've come" Todd Santabarbara provided an update on a variety of celebrations, including (1) the transition to the rSchoolToday scheduling and assigning platform, (2) the sections leadership throughout the state through its creation and implementation of it's Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Policy and the sections ongoing work with the InsideOut Initiative, (3) the expansion of sports such as Boys Volleyball, Flag Football and Girls Ice Hockey, (4) Our sections participation in the first ever Student Athlete Leadership Conference, and finally (5) enhanced championship branding and student experience.
- "Who can we be" Todd Santabarbara reviewed elements of the organization growth plan including the expansion of new and/or existing services, and the multi-year staffing plan to address the needs of the CIA and Section One member schools.

Matt Cameron shared that the organizational growth plan should be widely supported and will help to serve the member schools. This support was echoed by other members of the Executive Committee including Dr. Felicello and Dr. Bonk. Dr. Borsari encouraged the Executive Director to work toward the ideal office. He shared that the strides made in recent years and the evolution of interscholastic athletics require additional support.

#### VIII. NYSPHSAA Update

(I) Overview of the approved items from the May 3<sup>rd</sup> NYSPHSAA Executive Committee agenda Susan Reid & Rob Pollok, Section 1 Female & Male NYSPHSAA AD Rep

#### Discussion:

Todd Santabarbara reviewed the newly adopted sportsmanship standard which clearly outlines the penalty that spectators must abide by when ejected from a contest. Jesse Merchant provided clarification on the non-sequential nature of the standard.

# (I) Sectional Concern: Inequity in Regional Rotations

## **Discussion**:

Todd Santabarbara provided information regarding our section's concern over the inequity in the regional rotations in certain sports. The existing regional rotations do not align with the NYSPHSAA Championship Philosophy. Within the current regional rotation, certain sections never participate in a sub-regional round before entering the state tournament. The example provided was baseball, which currently does not require Sections 2,3,5,6,8 & 11 to participate in a sub-regional game which in turn puts additional burden on the remaining sections in the following ways:

- Additional expense of hosting sub-regional events
- The regular season is condensed because the last day to play for the purpose of seeding must occur earlier.
- Additional cost to districts for transportation
- Loss of instructional time

# (I) NYSPHSAA Superintendent Rep – Term Expires 8/31/23

#### Discussion:

Todd Santabarbara requested that members of the Committee begin thinking of possible candidates to replace the outgoing Superintendent Rep.

(I) NYSPHSAA Spalding Ball Adoption Extension: 2024-2029

#### Discussion:

Todd Santabarbara shared the Spalding Ball Adoption Extension through 2029. This agreement provides \$36,310 in annual rights fees each year for the life of the agreement as well as the retail product credit and Spalding product quantities.

### IX. Self-Reports

• Riverside Boys Basketball – use of ineligible player Rob Webb & James Hoffman, Riverside Athletic Director

Riverside used an ineligible player on their Varsity Boys Basketball team. The Athletic Director reported that one of their student-athletes went through the transfer process and recorded an inaccurate date for his entry into 9<sup>th</sup> grade. Upon identifying the error in the transfer paperwork, the Athletic Director removed him from the program and spoke with the parents/guardians of the athlete. As a result of the player participating in contests, the prescribed NYSPHSAA penalty was applied resulting in a forfeiture of the applicable games. The Athletic Council determined that no further sanction was necessary.

• Yonkers Varsity Track & Field – use of ineligible player(s)

Rob Webb & Joe Gizzo, Yonkers Public Schools, Athletic Director

Yonkers used ineligible players within their Varsity Track & Field program in competitions. The school's Athletic Director reported that eight of their student-athletes had participated in a meet prior to meeting their individual practice requirement therefore rendering them ineligible. As a result of the ineligible players participating, the prescribed NYSPHSAA penalty was applied resulting in a forfeiture of the meet. The Committee was made aware that the coach has also been suspended for the remainder of the season. The Athletic Council determined that no further sanction was necessary.

• Hastings Varsity Baseball – pitch count violation Drew Wendol, Hastings Athletic Director

Hastings reported a violation of the NYSPHSAA pitch count rule resulting in the forfeiture of their varsity baseball game versus Putnam Valley. The Athletic Director reported that their coaching staff failed to record one of their batters resulting in a misrepresentation of the total number of pitches thrown during the game. The Athletic Director stated that he did not believe the coaches utilized the required NYSPHSAA pitch chart nor were pitch counts verified between innings. The Athletic Council imposed a one game suspension on the Head Coach.
