Application Requirements

- 1. Must be currently an 8th grader
- 2. A B average is required to attend each school.
- 3. Must be currently enrolled in Algebra I or a higher math class and have proof of residency on file at N.B. Clements. Must have successful completion of Algebra I to be enrolled at both schools.
- 4. Private or home schools must have proof of residency(lease or deed) and proof of Algebra I for high school credit with a A/B average.

- 2 recommendations for MLWGSGIS – (7th or 8th grade social studies or foreign language teacher and a current faculty member)
- 2. 2 recommendations for ARGS (from the focus area and a 7th grade English, math, science, or social studies teacher
- 3. Completed application must be turned in to N.B.
 Clements Counseling Office by 3 pm on December 1, 2020
- ARGS applicants must complete an adjudication – TBA
- Maggie Walker applicants must complete an assessment - TBA

How Do I Get An Application?

- 1. Applications will be available on October 15, 2020.
- 2. Requests must be made by taking a picture, on your cell phone, of the QR code on the right of this page. Then fill out the google form on your phone and press submit.
- 3. The Counseling Department will notify students for pickup.
- 4. Application deadline will be December 1, 2020 by 3:00 p.m.
- 5. Applications must be completed by the December 1, 2020 deadline.

Practical Details

Points to Consider

- Acceptance is a 4- year commitment. Students who fail to maintain academic and behavior standards could be sent back to Prince George.
- Final acceptance is pending successful completion of Algebra I or a higher math.
- Private or home school students must enroll in Prince George School ASAP as the school year ends.
- 4. Private or home school students may want to take the Algebra I SOL for verified credit.



Transportation/Cost

- Transportation will be provided to and from the Governor's Schools (parents must make arrangements to get the student to PGHS and home). Details are forthcoming.
- 2. The school division pays for the student's tuition.
- 3. If Drivers Education is desired, parents will be responsible for set-up through PGHS and responsible for the fee
