XI. General Action/Discussion/Informational Items:

(I) Nomination of Richard Calkins as Southern Westchester Superintendent representative for three-year term effective immediately *Southern Westchester Chief School Administrators*

<u>Discussion</u>: The Southern Westchester CSA solicited interested candidates to replace Joe Ricca on the Executive Committee. The SW CSA is nominating Richard Calkins as their second rep for a three- year term. Female representatives were contacted; however, they were not able or not interested to serve at this time.

(A) Consider amending the status of modified winter sports *Modified Committee*

<u>Discussion</u>: The Executive Committee intends to revisit the winter modified sports start date at the beginning of January. The Modified Committee met this morning to discuss the status of winter modified sports. Jesse provided an overview of what was discussed. The Modified Committee unanimously supported allowing districts to make a local decision (beginning January 19th) on offering the authorized low and moderate risk winter sports. This includes boys swim and indoor track which as of right now, has no facility.

Conference 1 - In favor of making local decisions. Would like the grouping to be regional.

Conference 2 – *Took a straw poll of the people in attendance. 15 were in favor of making a local decision, 4 in opposition, 1 abstained due to not having modified sports.*

Conference 3 – *The majority was not in favor of offering winter modified programs.*

No action was taken by the Athletic Council. The Executive Committee will revisit the January 19th start date at their next scheduled meeting.

(A) Consider amending the spectator policy for low/moderate winter risk sports

- Reassessment of the Fall Season I spectator policy as it pertains to low/moderate risk winter sports: • Bowling - alleys are not allowing spectators
 - O Dowling alleys are not allowing specialors
 - Indoor Track the Armory is not allowing spectators
 - \circ Fencing waiting to hear from the nine schools that have fencing
 - \circ Gymnastics clubs have their own policies
 - o Boys swimming will be holding virtual meets indoors

Conference 1 - In favor of two, per home athlete, for outdoor low and moderate risk sports. No indoor spectators

Conference 2 - In favor of two, per home athlete, where a venue permits it. If a school has a facility that can accommodate it, they should be allowed to do so

Conference 3 - Was not discussed

Motion to allow two spectators, per home athlete, for outdoor low and moderate risk winter events. No spectators for indoor winter events: Young / Casarella Defeated: 3 / 5 / 4

Motion to follow the venues guidelines for low and moderate risk sports. Lodewick / Drosopoulos Approved: 8/2/2

(A) Consider the amended scoring proposal for all Rockland County regular season bowling matches *Joe Casarella, North Rockland*
