Welcome, Rodney Arthur!



This week, after an exhaustive and intensive search process, the Board of Education appointed Mr. Rodney Arthur to the position of MS/HS Principal, effective July 1.

Our search committee had very high standards, and they were highly impressed with Mr. Arthur's philosophy and dedication. In conversations with Mr. Arthur, he cites initiatives and improvement efforts fluently with rich content and substance. He does not just talk the talk; he walks the walk.

His references spoke to his unwavering work ethic and the high standards he holds of students, staff, and, most importantly, himself. Mr. Arthur has worked in large, diverse districts and led change in complex systems. He has sought out our small district for its sense

of community and academic prestige. He knows with this staff, board, and administration, we can lead the district to higher levels.

His experience with the International Baccalaureate program is particularly exciting. A worldwide pre-college program founded to provide students the opportunity to receive a rigorous, connected education, IB courses are intended to develop students' intellectual, emotional, personal, and social skills. In his presentation to the search committee, he scaffolded teachers' use of divergent questioning through the use of question starters and discussion protocols. Within the framework of IB, he shared command terms like analyze, clarify, and interpret to ensure students are pushing the depths of concepts learned in their classrooms.

Over the next few weeks, Mr. Arthur will take time to get to know the leaders, staff, students, and families of TMS/THS. We are developing a schedule to ensure he hits the ground running. He has a bold vision, and his respect for our Tuckahoe scholars and their potential is apparent.




