



Request to Identify Parents on Active Duty in the Armed Forces

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Federal law requires the NYC Department of Education to report each year on students who have parent(s) on active duty in the armed forces. We need your help to meet this requirement because families are the best source for this information. The government uses this information to help understand the best ways to support these students.

The Armed Forces are the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, the Coast Guard, or full-time National Guard. Active duty means full-time duty in the active military service of the United States. Such term includes full-time training duty, annual training duty, and attendance, while in the active military service, at a school designated as a service school by law or by the Secretary of the military department concerned.

If you provided this information last year and your student still has a parent on active duty, please complete this form again. We are required to collect information each year. If this situation does not apply to your child, you may disregard this form.

My student has had a parent or guardian on active duty in the armed forces at any time between July 1, 2022, and today.
