


3rd Grade News

In math, we have been learning about data. We learned how to read and interpret data in a bar graph, pictograph, and a line plot. We solved one-step and two-step word problems using information from these graphs. We finished the unit with a data project where third grade scholars used their knowledge of graphs to collect and analyze information from their classmates.

We will be getting ready for our next unit soon which will focus on understanding multiplication.

Writing


In writing we are working on writing persuasive speeches. We learned that in order to make or speeches powerful and effective, opinion writers need to address their
