**COVID 19 Quarantine and Isolation Duration Guidelines** 

- A. For Exposures (Those who were within 6 feet of a confirmed case for ≥ 15 min<sup>1</sup>)
  - Unvaccinated OR Incompletely vaccinated individuals Quarantine at home for at least 10 days,\*
    possibly longer if symptoms develop or test positive (see case isolation below). At the end of
    quarantine must continue to wear mask indoors for 4 more days. A negative COVID test does
    not change or shorten the quarantine and masking requirements.
  - <u>Vaccinated individual, Asymptomatic</u> No quarantine necessary. However, must wear a mask indoors for 14 days. Should test in 3-5 days.
    - o Test result Positive- refer to case isolation below
    - Test result Negative-continue to wear mask in indoor settings for 14 days as above.
  - <u>Vaccinated individual, Symptomatic</u> facilitate testing with PCR test. Consider as positive and isolate pending results.
    - o Test Result Positive refer to case isolation below
    - Test Result negative no home quarantine but mask indoors for 14 days (this is or the low chance of false negative result). If suspicion remains high, consider retesting.
- B. For Cases (Test positive)
  - <u>SYMPTOM BASED STRATEGY</u> Isolated at least 10 days after symptom onset, provided that symptoms are improving and patient is fever free without medication x 24 hours.
  - Rockland County DOES NOT recommend Test based strategy (TBS) to shorten duration
    of isolation. TBS should only be used for hospitalized patients with prolonged symptom
    resolution or in those who are immunocompromised who may have prolonged shedding
    of the virus. For those patients, employ 2 negative results of PCR test 24 hrs apart, an
    afebrile period of 24 hours without medication, and a minimum of 10 days isolation from
    symptom of onset to decide on discontinuing isolation.

\*Note: CDC recommends that EXPOSED/QUARANTINED cases may discontinue quarantine after 7 days if patient tested negative after day 5, New York State and Rockland County <u>DO NOT FOLLOW THIS RECOMMENDATION.</u>

in the P-12 indoor classroom setting **students** who were within 3-6 feet of an infected student where both students were engaged in consistent & correct use of well-fitting masks are not considered close contacts. This exception does not apply to teachers, staff, or other adults in the indoor classroom setting.

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
