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Who is eligible to take the exams?

- All 3rd, 4th, and 5th Grade students
- Blended and Full Remote Learners



Differences Between Testing in 2021 Compared to Previous Years

- Students must OPT-IN to take the test (instead of OPT-OUT). The OPT-IN form is on the Lucero311.org website.
- One-Day exam, multiple choice
- YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE PENALIZED IF HE/SHE DOES NOT TAKE THE EXAM.



If my child is a Full Remote Learner, how will the test be given?

- ALL tests given in person.
- A Lucero staff member will contact you to arrange a date and time to drop off and pick your child.
- Planning on a specific date helps to ensure proper health and safety for all.



OPT-IN Dates

- Anyone interested in their child taking the ELA, Math, and 4th Grade
 Science Exams must sign up by the following dates:
 - Now-April 15 (child can take ELA, Math, and 4th Grade Science)
 - April 15-April 29 (child can take Math and 4th Grade Science)
 - April 29-May 28 (child can take 4th Grade Science)



Exam Dates

- ELA: Tuesday, April 20; or Wednesday, April 21; or Thursday, April 22
- Math: Tuesday, May 4 or Wednesday, May 5
- 4th Grade Science: Tuesday, June 8 or Wednesday, June 9

Who is eligible to take the exams?

- All Blended Learning K-5th grade students who are English Language Learners--ONLY
- Full Remote Learners will not take the exam



Differences Between Testing in 2021 Compared to Previous Years

- Blended Learning students do not have to OPT-IN, they are required to take the exam
- The test will continue to test for Speaking, Listening, Reading, and Writing.



Exam Dates

- Speaking test will be conducted from April-May
- Writing, Reading, and Listening will be on Tuesday, May 18 and Wednesday May 19.
