We are excited to offer enhanced and expanded **Summer Opportunities** again for PCPS students preK-12. Powhatan High School and Flat Rock Elementary School will host the majority of summer activities. The summer session will be **June 27-July 21**. We hope to see many of our students taking advantage of the following opportunities:

Learning Recovery



Elementary: Our themed summer school will be full-day, lunch provided, with door-to-door transportation and daily camp-like resource activities, including art, physical education, and world languages. School administrators will be inviting students during the month of April.

Secondary: Middle and high school students who failed courses can take recovery courses in core areas for promotion to the next level. *Registration will begin on May 16.*

Credit Advancement



Secondary: Students who would like to take courses for advancement may take online options with PCPS Staff (Health/PE, Economics and Personal Finance) or with one of our online course providers (multiple course offerings). There are fees associated with credit advancement courses. *Registration will begin on May 16.*

Enrichment and Athletic Camps



K-12: There are a variety of athletic and enrichment camps this summer. These camps are designed by PCPS teachers and staff for students k-12 to enhance instruction from the 21-22 school year. In addition, the PMS and PHS athletic departments will offer a variety of athletic camps for students. Participants may use the transportation provided for our Learning Recovery Students. There are fees associated with athletic camps. *Registration is open and payments will be accepted beginning on April 13.*
