Mask Wearing Protocols

All students and staff will be required to wear face coverings/masks throughout the day.

- Masks must cover the mouth and nose.
- Students must board their school bus with their mask on and keep their mask on throughout the time they are on the bus.
- Students must be wearing their mask upon entering any school building.
- Students will be able to take off their masks for lunch and during teacher designated "mask breaks". This will generally be a time where students are outside and six feet apart, or inside during a quiet time when students are six feet apart.

Tips for Parents:

- ⇒ If your children have not already practiced wearing a mask, start having designated times for them to wear a mask so they can get used to it. Review the <u>recommendations for how to wear a mask</u> with your children.
- ⇒ If your child is going to wear cloth masks, he/she should have several so the masks can be washed daily. See CDC information on washing masks.
- ⇒ Let your children pick out cloth masks that reflect their likes and personalities.
 Please note all Code of Conduct dress rules apply to masks.
- ⇒ Please remind younger ones–<u>No sharing masks allowed!</u>
- \Rightarrow All masks must be labeled with your child's name.
- ⇒ Your children should have a spare, labeled mask in a labeled ziplock bag, in their book bag in the event they misplace or soil their mask.
- ⇒ Schools will have disposable masks in the event a child loses his/ hers.
