Education of a special act school district to retain funds in excess of the school district's allowable and reimbursable costs incurred for services and programs provided to school-age

students to support fiscal stabilization;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Mount Pleasant Cottage School Union Free School District hereby establishes a Fiscal Stabilization Reserve Fund pursuant to Section 4004(5) of the Education Law, to permit the retention of funds in excess of the school district's allowable and reimbursable costs incurred for services and programs provided to school-age students, provided that (1) the amount of funds to be retained annually will not exceed 1% of the school district's total allowable and reimbursable costs for programs and services for school-age students for the school year from which the funds are retained; (2) the total accumulated balance that may be retained may not exceed 4% of such total costs for that school year; (3) such funds will not be recoverable on reconciliation of tuition rates; (4) such funds shall be separate from and in addition to any other authorization to retain surplus funds on reconciliation; and (5) the funds may only be expended for a purpose expressly authorized as part of the approved tuition methodology for the year the funds will be expended, except that funds may be expended to pay prior year outstanding debts; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board hereby appropriates a sum not to exceed \$181,602 from the 2021-2022 General Fund for such purpose and authorizes the transfer of

such funds to the Fiscal Stabilization Reserve Fund.
