



What We're Learning

Reading/Writing: Our students have been introduced to the letters N, W, P, H, M, A, B, K, D, F, O, C, E, Y, G. We have learned about the sounds each of these letters make and things that begin with these letters. This month we will learn about the letters **T** and **S**. We continue to work on writing letters and working on writing our names.

Math: We have learned about the numbers 1-10 and counting with 1:1 correspondence to 10. We will continue to focus on these skills and begin working on addition. We will introduce the addition sign (+), the equals sign (=) and counting "How many all together" to add items.

Science: During our interdisciplinary unit **Light**, we will explore what kind of light is around us and how light helps us. We will experiment with shadows and how shadows are made. As well as with seeds and how light helps seeds grow.

Social Studies: February is Black History Month and we will learn about the life, work and important message of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

Color/Shape: This month, we will focus on the color Red and the shape Heart. We have learned many shapes and colors. To help reinforce color and shape skills, when
