Celebrations:

- Administration and teachers have been flexible with all the safety updates from the NYCDOE. Kudos to all!
- Ms. Coniglio started her in class safety lessons for various topics of safety in school, outside of school and online. Dean Coniglio continues whole grade lessons as well.

OORS update:

- Minor incidents in school are handled through classroom management by staff.
- OORS incidents do occur after school hours on the gaming sites and social media; Students are supported through focused lessons on cyber safety with the Dean.

Drill Update:

- All safety drills have been completed before the new year 2022.
- Next drills are due in mid February
- Bus drills have been completed

Covid-19 Update:

- Faculty is given two covid home kits per week
- A letter was given to each student for families regarding new Covid protocols
- District is updating school buildings with news on Covid-19 safety for school community.
- Schools will remain open
- Students and staff will quarantine as fit for the regulations from the situation room.
- If there is a positive case, the student will receive covid home testing kit
- The quarantine for staff is 6 days.
- Health screening has been updated
- Title of letter for covid exposure has been updated. There is one letter for more than one case.
- School testing is still occurring
- Parents should be checking the NYC students account daily
- PPE is provided daily for staff and for each classroom. This includes wipes, masks, gloves and hand sanitizer. If needed please see Ms. Papa
- Staff Testing kits are given to staff by Ms. Vellon
- Student kits are sent home via child's backpack
- Kits are provided for the school nurse

- Bob gives PPE to administration and to his custodial staff
- Spraying is continuing throughout the school
- Classrooms are remaining social distanced

Building Updates:

- Spraying for Covid every evening

Agent Calder:

- Shortage of safety agents
