## **Senior Year Timeline**

### September/October

- Register for SAT / ACT
- Complete Teacher Recommendation Profile Sheets and give them to the teachers who you are asking for letters of recommendation from
- Complete the **Transcript Release Form** and return it to Guidance
- Complete the E-mail Permission Form and return it to Guidance
- Complete your Brag Sheet and return it to Guidance
- Write your college essay
- Create a resume
- Finalize college list (make sure to include financial and admission safety schools in your list)
- Collect and complete college applications. See if your schools are on the Common Application (www.commonapp.org)
- Create a timeline for deadlines (applications, financial aid). Note: You should submit applications to Guidance AT LEAST two weeks before the application due date
- Complete a PRHS Online Application Form for any schools you have applied to on line, and return it to your counselor.
- Complete supplemental applications if your schools require them
- Release SAT scores through www.collegeboard.com and/or ACT scores through www.actstudent.org to the schools you are applying to

Prepare for mid-year exams

# **February**

 Mid- year reports automatically sent to each school to which a senior applies. This is done after report cards are printed.

## March

- Register for Advanced Placement Tests in the Guidance Office
- □ Letters begin to arrive from colleges

## **April**

 Student notification of acceptance continues. Make sure to notify schools you have decided not to attend so that others may have an opportunity.

## May

- □ Deposits due May 1<sup>st</sup> at most competitive colleges
- Review financial packages
