1. SUPERINTENDENT SEARCH

Conduct a search for the next Superintendent of Schools with goal of having replacement by end of the current school year.

2. CURRICULUM

The Board of Education will ensure growth and academic achievement by supporting academic priorities that align with the 2019-2022 district strategic goals. The Board will allocate time at monthly meetings for presentations on progress of the four goals: social emotional, diverse learners, contemporary teaching/learning and professional learning.

3. COMMUNICATION

Improve Board communication with all stakeholders (parents, students, staff, etc.) in the community to exhibit transparency and build trust:

- V. "Town Hall" meetings

4. POLICY REVIEW

Work collaboratively with administration, staff and community to revise policies that require updating, initiating and/or amending

- II. Homework policy
- III. Class size policy
- IV. Tutoring and Coaching policy

- V. Siwanoy Blvd use/closure/maintenance policy
- VI. Data Collection/use/reporting policy

5. FACILITIES

Ensure that the District facilities support a high-quality teaching and learning environment to enhance student achievement

- I. Capital project Firm up Cottle Field Plan
- II. Establish a Capital Improvement Reserve Fund
- III. Request, review and approve a comprehensive classroom/library renovation plan for the 2020-2021 budget
- IV. Develop preliminary plans for a possible follow-up capital project upon completion of the existing one. (No action necessarily, but begin conducting discussions/workshops regarding what the scope of a follow-on project could encompass, and how it could be funded)

6. FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT & BUDGET PLANNING

The Board will make every effort to operate the District within the NYS imposed Tax Cap while maintaining high quality education programs. The Board will also continue to consider all cost saving and revenue generating opportunities for the District.
