CAMP DESCRIPTIONS

DAY CAMP | AGES 5.5 - 11

Day Campers will engage in specialist-led activities that will enhance their social and emotional skills, help keep their academics on track, keep them physically active and challenge them to learn new things every day. Through our newly designed day camp program, activity specialists in music, arts, STEM and recreation will give our campers the opportunity to make new friends and take exciting trips throughout New York City. Campers will participate in a wide range of sports, instructional swimming, arts and crafts, and weekly themed activities based on our 2017 theme "Once Upon A Time, Happens Once Upon A Day". In addition, campers will engage in a variety of science, technology, engineering and math activities through each session. Day campers will be divided into age groups with children no more than 1-2 years apart in age.

TEEN CAMP | AGES 12 - 15

Teen Camp is open to 12-15 year olds currently enrolled in middle or high school. A Teen Camp experience instills the values of accountability and teamwork in addition to the YMCA's core values of honesty, respect, caring and responsibility. Teen campers participate in hands-on programming geared towards building self-confidence as well as activities designed to engage teens in developing educational and career goals. Field trips are purposeful in connecting teen campers to real-world experiences with technology, art and character development through team-building. Plus swimming, dancing, singing, sports and more!



WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

STAFF

The counselors are 18+ years old and experienced in working with children. Ratios for children are as follow:

AGE 5:	6:1
AGES 6 - 8:	8:1
AGES 9 - 14:	10:1
AGES 15+:	12:1

*There is a 5:1 ratio with all ages when on a trip.

All staff are thoroughly vetted and trained by our professional facilitators for a minimum of 40 hours before camp begins. Trainings covered include: Behavior management, ages & stages of development, risk management, lesson implementation, and professionalism just to name a few.

FACILITY

Housed in the Flushing YMCA, Day Camp operates in various classroom settings. Each room is air-conditioned and equipped with age-appropriate materials, arts supplies and cubbies. Campers play outdoors, using the YMCA playground or Weeping Beech Park on Bowne Street. On days when it is too hot or raining, the children use the indoor gymnasium and racquet courts. Campers will enjoy recreational and educational opportunities throughout the YMCA.

SWIMMING

Campers swim three times a week in a small, warm pool dedicated to lessons. All counselors are in the water, and two swim instructors, and a lifeguard supervise the children in the water at all times. The YMCA believes in a nurturing approach to swimming. Children are never forced into the water but gently cajoled. Usually, before you know it, everyone is happily splashing.

FIELD TRIPS

Campers participate in bi-weekly, age appropriate field trips, using various forms of transportation. Field trips to museums and science centers will link to the camp-based activities and maximize educational enrichment.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

Lunch is provided free of charge by Dep't of School Foods and is eaten at the Flushing HS across the street. A light snack is given to the campers in the afternoon. On Trip days parents will need to provide lunch for their child/ren.

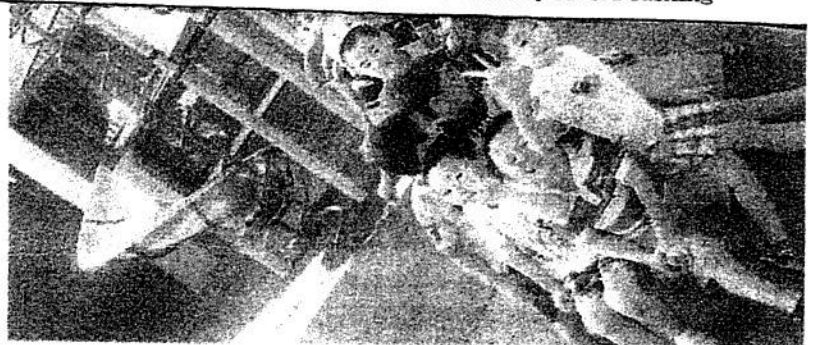
該夏令營持有紐約州政府、紐約市政府、教育局、衛生局、美國紅十字會、聯邦教師公會註冊登記執照。著重寓教於樂的王老師夏令營由多位優秀教師及王老師安親班聯合主理營務，自7月1日展開至8月14日結束，每週一至五上午八時卅分到下午四時，日程安排德智體群並重，多樣豐富。免費供應早餐及午餐。其教學與活動安排緊湊，內容為：上午上課—全新課程有英文閱讀、科學理化、紐約州市會考題測試、預習新學期課業、精算金腦班。下午為才藝及課外活動，如美勞、棋藝、演講、益智遊戲、中文。另外，還有週六彈性安

排活動，額外參加。

該夏令營營址在20小學內，校舍、教室、用餐間和遊樂場都是教育局認定，課程均由具豐富經驗的教授、教師耐心教學，助理人員帶領學員細心關照。採用特殊教學法，注重培養獨立自信的人格。

另外，王老師安親班提供全年制的課後輔導每週一至週五下午2時30分-6時，由執照教師負責指導學齡前至六年級學生，除了輔導學生完成學校作業之外，還有加強閱讀及寫作、益智提昇訓練、考試補習一對一、執照教師雙語輔導，務使新移民子女迎頭趕上學校課業。
