Accommodated Test Window: April 14-27, 2020
Makeup Administration: April 28, 2020
\*PED and College Board will work with districts that may need a different window.



Graduation requirements for Cohort 2023 (students now in grade 9) will be published before the end of 2019.

All students have access to 8 full length practice test on Khan Academy. Students will need to set up practice accounts. Instructions for establishing these accounts are posted on the <u>PED SAT site.</u>

SLRT forms /accommodation are in the google docs. Remember these are to be kept on your campus for 5 years.

If a student attended kindergarten, that year will count as the first recognized year is U.S. schools. As such, a student who enters school in kindergarten may test in Spanish through  $2^{nd}$  grade and could continue testing in Spanish with a waiver in  $3^{rd}$  and  $4^{th}$  grades. This student will be required to test in English in  $5^{th}$  grade. REMEMBER TO ACCOUNT FOR RETENTIONS.

Counting kindergarten as a school year for the purposes of testing in Spanish went into effect 2015-2016 school year. When completing waivers, please pay particular attention to your 5<sup>th</sup> graders, noting that they are **not** eligible for a waiver if they attended U.S. school in kindergarten and have been in U.S. schools each consecutive year since regardless of the fact that they may have used a 1<sup>st</sup> waiver during the 14-15 school year.

Spanish-speaking students may take accountability assessments in Spanish for their first 3 consecutive years in U.S. schools. Waivers of testing in English, which allow students to continue testing in Spanish, are available for students in their  $4^{th}$  and  $5^{th}$  years in U.S. schools.

Waivers will be due to this office no later than the 3rd of December. Waivers have not been given to us by NMPED as of today however please be prepared to fill those out upon delivery.
