What Makes Habitudes So Different?

One course in the Habitudes series is Habitudes for Self-Leadership: The Art of Leading Yourself which was designed as a Character Education curriculum. This course uses unique modules to teach life and leadership skills to students in a way that they will actually enjoy, engage with, and see results from. Each lesson follows a customized formula to best engage the Generation Z student. This simple formula is as follows:



Engage - Start with an opening activity to capture your participants' attention.



Connect - Ask critical questions to get participants to connect with the lesson.



Habitude - Teach the image by either showing the video or sharing the summary and a key story.



Converse - Utilize the discussion questions to start a class-wide conversation about the principle.




Personalize - Help your participants figure out how they will apply the Habitude to your context.


Course Implementation & Results




