## PHYSICAL EDUCATION CLASS MAKE UPS

Physical Education make-up classes for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter will be held Monday, Tuesday and Thursday, June 4, 5 and 7, 2018. Make-up classes will begin at 2:15 and student must be prepared for activity. This is **only** offered to students with excessive "excused" absences or who have been unprepared for class on occasion.

### SPORT PHYSICALS

Sports Physicals for the 2018-19 seasons will be offered on Thursday, June 7<sup>th</sup> at 2:15 in the Main gymnasium. Any student who plans to participate in a fall, winter or spring sport will need a recent physical to be eligible. Private physicals will be accepted as well. Effective 7/18, the mandated years for health exams & screening will change. Health examinations will be required in grades 9<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup>. Other required years will be K, 1, 3, 5, 7<sup>th</sup> as well. Therefore all 11<sup>th</sup> graders are required by New York State to have a recent physical by their private physician or they can have it done by Dr. Ingrassia the school physician on this date. Tenth graders should consider taking advantage of this so they have a recent physical on file for the start of the 2017-18 school year. Please contact Mrs. M. ### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

# Revisions to School Health Services Regulations Effective 7/1/18:

Health exams will be required in grades K, 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11.

Vision screening for distance & near vision acuity will be required within 6 months of admission to school and in grades Pre K or K, 1, 3, 5, 7, and 11.

Hearing screening utilizing pure tone testing will be required within 6 months of admission to school for K, 1, 3, 5, 7, and 11.

Scoliosis screening will be required in grades 5 and7 for girls and grade 9 for boys.

2018/19 will be a transition year and any health exam form signed by a Dr., N.P. or P.A. will be accepted. But for the 2019-2020 school year, ONLY the approved NYSED form will be accepted.

For 2018/19: All 12<sup>th</sup> graders must submit by proof of the meningococcal vaccine – 2 doses.

11<sup>th</sup> graders: Recent Physical Exam forms must be on file.
