PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Institute offers rising high school seniors and college freshmen a unique opportunity to develop the knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary to create positive change on environmental issues in their own local communities and the planet as a whole. The Institute is a six-day residential program providing an in-depth perspective on sustainability in today's environment, covering topics such as Water, Energy, Climate Change, Sustainability, and The Environment. Academic content will be drawn from a variety of disciplines including biology, chemistry and earth science. Hands-on activities inside and outside of the classrooms, discussion, lectures and experiments will be designed to actively engage students in the learning process. We will present students with complex issues and challenge them to consider multiple perspective and outcomes all while earning 3 college credits.

Students will reside in the College's residence halls and meals will be served in the McNelis Commons Dining Hall. Students will have access to the College's state-of-the-art science labs and experience outdoor activities in the rich ecosystem surrounding the College.
