Scheduling a Road Test

Scheduling a road test for a junior license (“DJ” license):

If you are 16 or 17 -- to schedule a road test for a “DJ” (Junior) license you need:

1. Your permit
2. The 5-hour pre-licensing certificate (MV-278) issued in class
3. The 50-hour certificate (MV-262) signed by a parent/guardian. This form can be downloaded at <http://www.nydmv.state.ny.us/forms/mv262.pdf>

Do not hand in the MV-285 (certificate of completion) at the time of your road test. It takes 4-6 weeks to replace a certificate. You cannot obtain a senior license (at age 17) without this certificate.

To convert your “DJ” (junior) license to a “D” (senior) license at age 17:

1. Go to DMV
2. Present your “DJ” license
3. Present the TOP portion of the MV-285 – Student Certificate of Completion Form.

The bottom portion of the certificate of completion (MV-285) should be sent to your insurance company if they offer a discount for completing a driver’s education program.

Remember – drive safely every time you get behind the wheel of the car!
