FIRST GRADE January class newsletter




First grade writers will be writing lots of information books about lots of different topics. They will learn how to use nonfiction text features in their very own chapter books.



ELA News

Students will continue to work on Details and Synthesis for the next few weeks. An important skill in reading and writing is learning to pay attention to characters and how they change or relationships they have. We also want to think about how authors teach us lessons in stories. We will use all this information to write literary essays. We will then move into reading about the American Revolution!

Math News!

We will be doing a mini unit on factors and multiples in preparation for division! We will then move onto division of multi digit numbers up to the thousands place by a one digit number. We will be using different strategies: standard algorithm, repeated subtraction, distributive method and partial quotients.

Social Studies

We will be wrapping up our unit on the Native Americans. We will now learn about how our state began to be settled by explorers coming to the new world from the European Countries. This will then lead us to learn about the American Revolution.



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Fifth Grade Newsletter

January newsletter

Math:

The fifth grade will be transitioning from Using Models and Strategies to Multiply Decimals towards Using Models and Strategies to divide Whole Numbers.. We will also begin working on test taking strategies to enhance our ability to show what we know while proving our mathematical thinking while working on rigorous word problems.

ELA:

The fifth grade will be working on the Unit Argument and Advocacy. Students will be reading different materials and texts in their Book Clubs and working on research trying to prove or disprove an important issue. This reading and writing Unit lends itself towards writing research based essays.

Science:

Students will continue investigating the particle nature of matter and energy within the interactions of larger systems occurring on earth.

Social Studies: The fifth grade will be examining European Exploration. The Essential Question we will examine is: How do issues of power, wealth, and morality influence exploration and colonization? Students will read a wide range of material addressing these issues and engage in careful research.



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
